- **PRACTICE** responsible recreation that's inclusive and informed by a conservation ethic
- **MINIMIZE** impacts and conflicts with other users
- **CONTRIBUTE** solutions to land-management, conservation and recreation problems
- **RESPECT** land-management rules and regulations
